

Much of the E-A loop is off this map

- The roadbook runs the loops in this order: C (50mi), B (35mi), D (63mi), F (33mi), G (30mi), E-A (70mi).
- All loops start and finish at the same central pit point, as shown on map.
- Note the points on the map match roadbook waypoint names in the roadbook, where the "B" indicates the loop name, and the 3-digit number is sequential along that loop. Only a few of the points from the roadbook are included here.
- In a real rally race, you will not receive such a detailed map. So, you really should not be looking at this at all, except if you get lost or need to find a shortcut back to the bivouac. Fold it up, put it in your riding jacket pocket, and don't use it unless you really need it!
